Hi Everyone,

People are always asking how many horses are at HVEC and so I have put together a bit of a "fact sheet" on the variety of horses that live here:

Shaun's horses

Shaun has 5 ½ horses. They are Rudy, Regard, Rhannar, Roseman, Scarlet and the half is Risto, Scarlet's colt. 2 are black, 1 is bay and 2 ½ are chestnut. They are all Warmbloods.

Agistment horses

There are currently 21 horses on agistment. They are Chatty, Kismet, Vaulting Scarlet, Ben, Vaulting Cruise, Colin, Belle, Kaali, Roseamber, Ilky, Bill, Chilli, Rocky, Leo, Bobby, Rudi, Cruize, Mouse, Missy, Gabriel and Rimi. There is a huge variety in breeds – Warmblood, Riding Pony, Haflinger, Arabian x, Thoroughbred, Irish Sporthorse, Cleveland Bay, Andalusian, Standardbred and Stockhorse. There is a mix of black, brown, bay, chestnut, liver chestnut, grey, white and palomino.

There are 13 different horse owners. The horse owners live from Ashtonfield through to Newcastle, all in the Lower Hunter area. The heights of all of the horses at HVEC range from 12.1 hh to 17.3 hh!
