Hi Everyone,



The Olympic Venue

The Chateau de Versailles, an iconic symbol illustrating France's global reputation, will welcome the Olympic and Paralympic

Games in 2024 to a magnificent setting with a rich history.

A temporary outdoor arena, flanked by several stands, will be set up on the Etoile Royale esplanade to the west of the Grand Canal at the heart of the palace's gardens. This arena will stage dressage and eventing dressage, and showjumping and eventing showjumping. The eventing cross-country section will be held alongside the Grand Canal.
